


LUNA ROLL INSTRUCTION






Status LED Light Signals


Green Light	Blink Twice	Command received/ Wake from deep sleep
	Solid	RF Pairing mode
Red Light	Blink Twice	Enter deep sleep mode
	Solid	Error / Flat battery
	Constant Blinking	Low battery






1. Turn on Luna Roll

Press and hold the **PROG** button until the **Status LED** blinks green twice.



2. Choose Desired Channel



3. Set Channel

Hold down and button simultaneously. After 3-5 seconds, the **Status LED** on motor will flash green again, pairing is now complete.

Delete Current Channel




1. Hold **P1** + **P3** until motor jogs.

2. Hold \wedge + — untill motor jogs.

Delete All Channel

1. Hold **P1** + **P3** until motor jogs.



2. Hold \checkmark + — untill motor jogs.




How to Set Travel Limit with Remote




Before Set up: Make sure the motor is paired to the remote and the desired channel is selected.




1. Move blind to top*

Press and hold until the Luna Roll moves to the top.




2. Turn on CONFIG Mode

Press and hold the *P1* + *P3* button until the Luna Roll jogs to enter *CONFIG* mode.




3. Move blind to bottom

Press and hold until the Luna Roll moves to the bottom.




4. Set Bottom Limit

Press and hold the **P3 + P2** button until the Luna Roll jogs to set bottom limit.




5. Move blind to top

Press and hold until the Luna Roll moves to the top.



6. Set Top Limit

Press and hold the **P1** + **P2** button until the Luna Roll jogs to set top limit.



7. Exit CONFIG Mode

Press and hold — until the Luna Roll jogs to exist the **CONFIG** mode.

* Motor runs oppositie direction

If the motor runs in reverse, you may want to change the setting before continuing:

- Hold P1 + P3 together until the motor jogs for 6 seconds.
- Hold + , together until the motor jogs again.
- Hold until the motor jogs to exit CONFIG mode.

Note: The bottom limit must be set first

Due to the way the firmware is designed, the bottom limit must first be set before you can set the top limit. Limit setting must be completed in one go - that is: Enter *CONFIG* mode, set bottom limit, set top limit, exit *CONFIG* mode. If you exit *CONFIG* mode before both limits have been set, you will have to start over.

Limit Preset Controls and Setting

*Can only be done after limit setting. Select the channel paired with the motor.

After setting the top & bottom limits, the motor has 3 default preset positions: P1 (25%), P2 (50%), and P3 (75%) closed.

To Change Preset Limit Control

- 1. Hold the **P1** + **P3** button until the motor jogs to enter **CONFIG** mode.
- 2. Use \wedge and \vee buttons to adjust the roller blind position.
- 3. Hold the desired preset position button (*P1*, *P2* or *P3*) until motor jogs to save the current position.
- 4. Hold until the motor jogs to exist **CONFIG** mode.

To Clear Limit Control

- 1. Hold **P2** + **P3** until motor jogs.
- 2. Hold P2 + P1 until motor jogs.
- 3. Hold **P2** + **P3** until motor jogs.
